The First Grade Studies Guy Bond and Robert Dykstra, 1967/1997 One of the earliest comprehensive studies in the history of how young children begin to learn how to read (27 different individual projects coordinated by 27 different directors in which a cadre of researchers compared first-grade reading programs from 1964 to 1967 Cold War
